ADRA Shoebox Appeal 2012

Burkina Faso is a land-locked nation in West Africa. The country covers an area of 105,870 sq miles and has an estimated population of 16.9 million, 46% of which are 0-14 years of age. Many children in Burkina Faso are growing up without parental care. Thousands are orphaned by AIDS and many more have been abandoned by their parents due to their economic situation. Public health facilities either do not exist or are in a terrible condition. The children of Burkina Faso are in great need and you can help by filling a shoebox.

Please include the following in each box:

- Personal hygiene kit with soap, washcloths, toothbrush and toothpaste
- School supplies such as pens, pencils, notebooks etc (the children's first language is French so reading books may not be suitable)
- Other items such as underwear, flipflops, sandals, tee-shirts and small toys can also be included
- No food, sweets or battery operated toys

To help with distribution costs, please give £2.00 per box to Harry Wilby. All boxes to be wrapped, clearly marked for boy or girl with suitable age and brought to church on Sabbath 3 November.
